PRIVACY STATEMENT

Hastings and Rother U3A uses membership information to keep you informed about events, groups and activities as part of your membership. Hastings and Rother U3A's lawful basis for collecting this information is contract. In using your information Hastings and Rother U3A will:

- store it securely
- use it to communicate with you as a U3A member
- share your information with group convenors for those groups to which you belong
- share your name and address with a mailing company which distributes the newsletter and other information to members
- Send you general information about the Third Age Trust (the national organisation to which all U3As are affiliated), including direct mailing of Third Age Matters magazine.

GIFT AID

Hastings and Rother U3A is a charity, and Gift Aid is reclaimed by the u3a from the tax you pay for the current tax year. This boosts your donation by 25p of Gift Aid for every £1 you donate. Your membership subscription is counted as a donation, and signing up for Gift Aid considerably increases our funds, enabling us to keep subscriptions as low as possible. Your address, title and name are needed, and you must be a UK taxpayer. If you pay less Income Tax and/or Capital Gains Tax than the amount of Gift Aid claimed on all your donations in that tax year, it is however your responsibility to pay any difference.

Please notify the u3a if you:

- You want to cancel this declaration
 - change your name, title, or home address
- no longer pay sufficient tax on your income and/or capital gains. If you pay Income Tax at a higher or additional rate and want to receive the additional tax relief due to you, you must include all your Gift Aid donations on your Self-Assessment tax return or ask HM Revenue and Customs to adjust your tax code.
